- What if he had prosecuted her for adultery?
- What if he had not believed the Lord's message to him?

Inn Keeper

- Luke 2:7
- He had no room but still found some shelter for Mary and Joseph
- What if he had refused their support and not aided them?

Wise men

- Matthew 2:12
- They could have reported back to Herod.
- What if they had reported back?
- What if they had not headed God's warning?

Herod

- Matthew 2:16
- He really did try to stop Christmas by the Slaughter of the Innocents
- What if he had succeeded?
- What if he had been paying attention to prophecy and was waiting for Christ?
