## "Be" Attitudes **Brave**

## **Review**

- Jesus preached the "Sermon on the Mount" in Matthew 5, 6, & 7 and Luke 6
- He begins this sermon with the eight Beatitudes.
  - A beatitude is "the declaration of blessedness made by our Savior to particular r virtues." – Webster's 1828
- Each is tied to a state of blessedness "Blessed are the..."
  - This is more than just being happy or fortunate.
  - o It is to be content, fulfilled, and prosperous in a spiritual and not physical sense.
- In these short phrases, Christ illustrates what the attitude of a believer should be.

## **Peaceful**

- "Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." – Matthew 5:10
- I am going to focus not on being persecuted, but rather on the bravery to stand strong when attacked.
- Brave means "Courageous; bold; daring; intrepid; fearless of danger; as a brave warrior. It usually unites the sense of courage with generosity and dignity of mind; qualities often united." Webster's 1828
- Christians WILL BE attacked II Timothy 3:12, John 15:18, I Peter 4:12-14, I John 3:13, II Corinthians 4:17-10,
- The devil is out to attack us I Peter 5:8-9
- Being brave does not mean we look for fights, but that we stand for what is right.
- We must remember that is not we who must win, but Christ has already won every battle – John 16:33
- We have the armor of God to bring into battle Ephesians 6:10
  - Belt/girdle God's truth that binds all together vs. 14
  - o Breastplate Christ's righteousness guarding our vitals vs. 14
  - o Feet preparation of the Gospel of peace to stand upon vs. 15
  - Shield faith in God's wisdom, will, and works vs. 16
  - Helmet assurance of salvation vs. 17
  - Sword Word of God vs. 17
  - Offense prayer vs. 18
  - Defense watching/vigilance vs. 18
- "for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" persecution is proof that the saint's true home is not of this world Hebrews 11:38
